

Director's Note

Carrie the Musical is a story about the cyclical and escalating nature of cruelty, highlighting the ways inactive bystanders give space for cruel acts to repeat and escalate. While the show you are about to see has many differences from Stephen King's novel, what has not changed is that the horror of the story lies in its familiar contexts: bullying, abuse, and violent religious extremism, to name a few. To imagine yourself at the receiving end of these cruel circumstances is by far scarier than the supernatural, telekinetic element of the story.

Though the truly scary parts of this story are realistic, Carrie's telekinesis provides the fantastical twist that cements us in the genre of horror, rather than tragedy. Her telekinesis also drives the story forward, taking us on a journey to a very different outcome from one that might happen in the real world. It is easy to focus on this magical element because it plays such a large role in the show. However, in order to ground the show in real stakes, we began this process by thinking about what happens to people in the real world, who suffer at the hands of others without intervention. While you are watching the show, I ask you to consider this question: what would happen after the blood dump if Carrie did not have her powers?

While the telekinesis drives the story forward, what drives the escalation of Carrie's suffering forward is the herd mentality and bystander effect. For years, our lone survivor Sue casually participates in the bullying, then instigates and finally feels she goes too far. While she spends the remainder of the story trying to right her wrongs, she (along with the other students) has already spent her entire childhood helping set the stage for the bloodbath. The lesson Sue must learn and re-live in her own never-ending cycle is that when we fail to be responsible bystanders in response to cruelty, we allow for the gradual (and eventually the aggressive) escalation of suffering, often until the damage is irreversible. While Sue is not single-handedly responsible for Carrie's suffering, she is part of the system that makes this story possible.

We are all a part of many stories. Choosing inaction within these stories has consequences.






of theatre through participating in community productions as well as by serving as technical director at Bishop Watterson High School.



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
